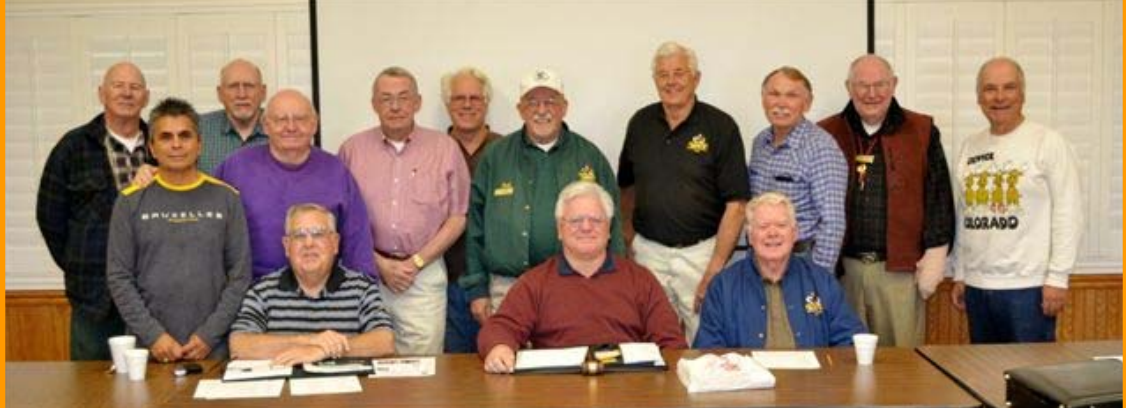

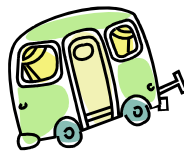
The following trips are planned so far for this year:
