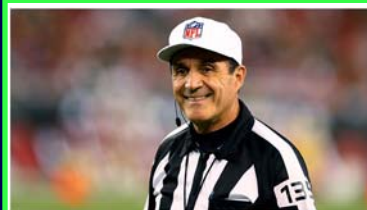

## FISHING CLUB



It has been decades since we had a wet spring like the one we are witnessing. It has provided good water conditions but poor fishing weather for the easy going laid back SIR's fishermen. LAKE PARDEE - The trout and Kokanee remain at the 30 to 60 foot levels. The report is some good bass fishing in and around the coves in the extreme south end of the Lake. Lots of fish in the 2 to 4 pound range mixed in with some largemouth. Anglers are most successful using Hot Shots and swimbaits. CAMANCHE LAKE - Large trout are still being caught 40 to 50 feet deep. Power bait (in rainbow, garlic, and chartreuse) and night-crawlers are still the bait of choice for anchored boaters. NEW MELONES – The Kokanee are getting most of the attention, however our Big Sir found out that the method used for catching Koks worked better for large trout. The upper creeks and rivers are flowing high and muddy.
