FISHING CLUB

Water conditions for the **COSUMNES AND MOKELUMNE RIVERS BASINS** are unusual for this time if year . The average water storage is between 109 and 150 percent of normal. It will be interesting to see the effect on the fishing this fall with the much higher storage. **LAKE CAMANCHE** is yielding catfish and bass. Trout anglers are trolling along the dam or by Hat Island. **LAKE PARDEE** is closed until February 2018. Catfishing is best at **AMADOR LAKE** using the



standard baits. At **CAPLES LAKE-SILVER LAKE** the trolling and shore fishing should be improving as the water cools. In the **AMERICAN & SACRAMENTO RIVERS** there are lots of salmon in the rivers, but salmon catching has been up and down. Most fish being caught are beautiful, bright, and hard-fighting.
